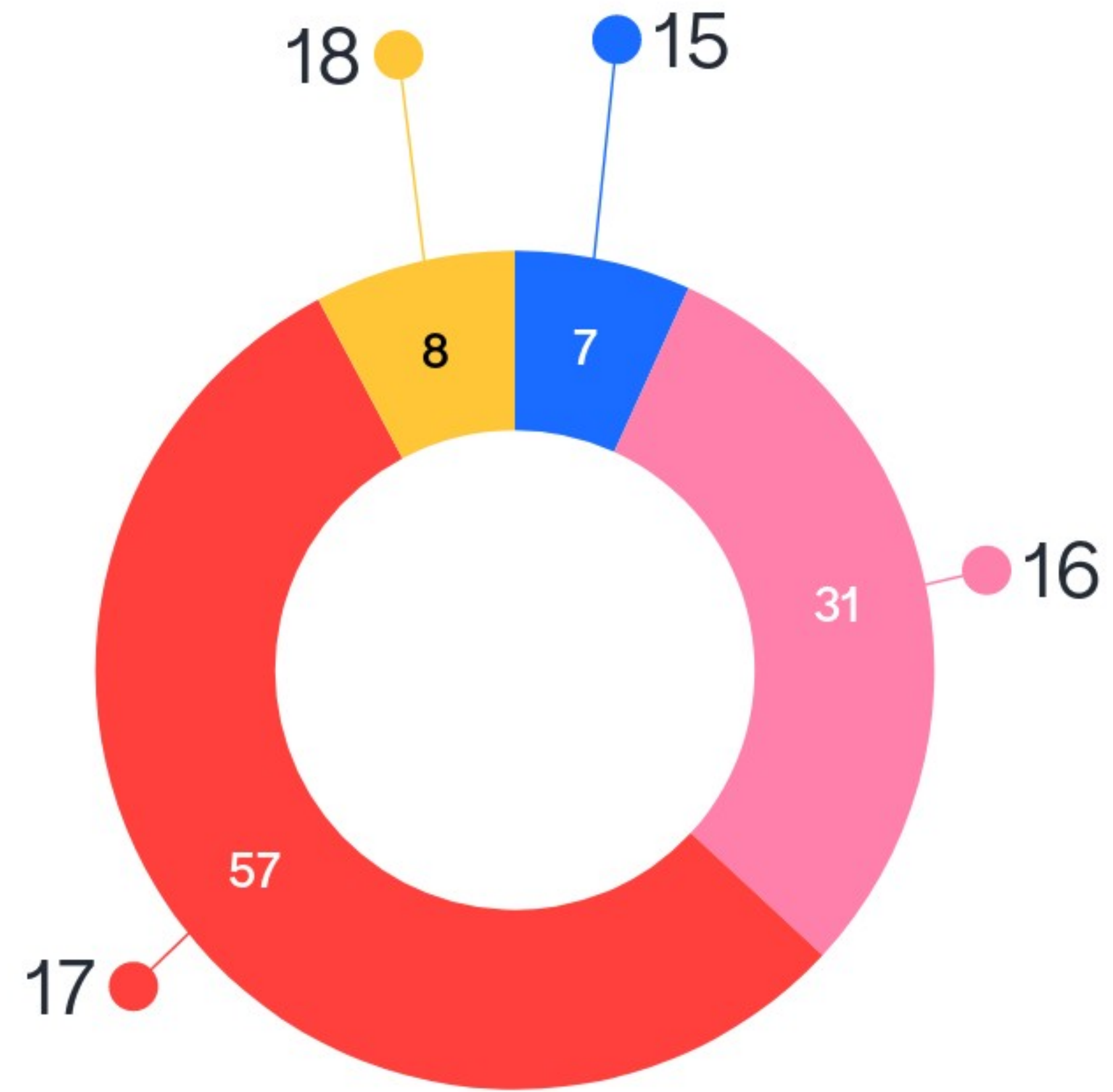


Urban Life in a Changing World

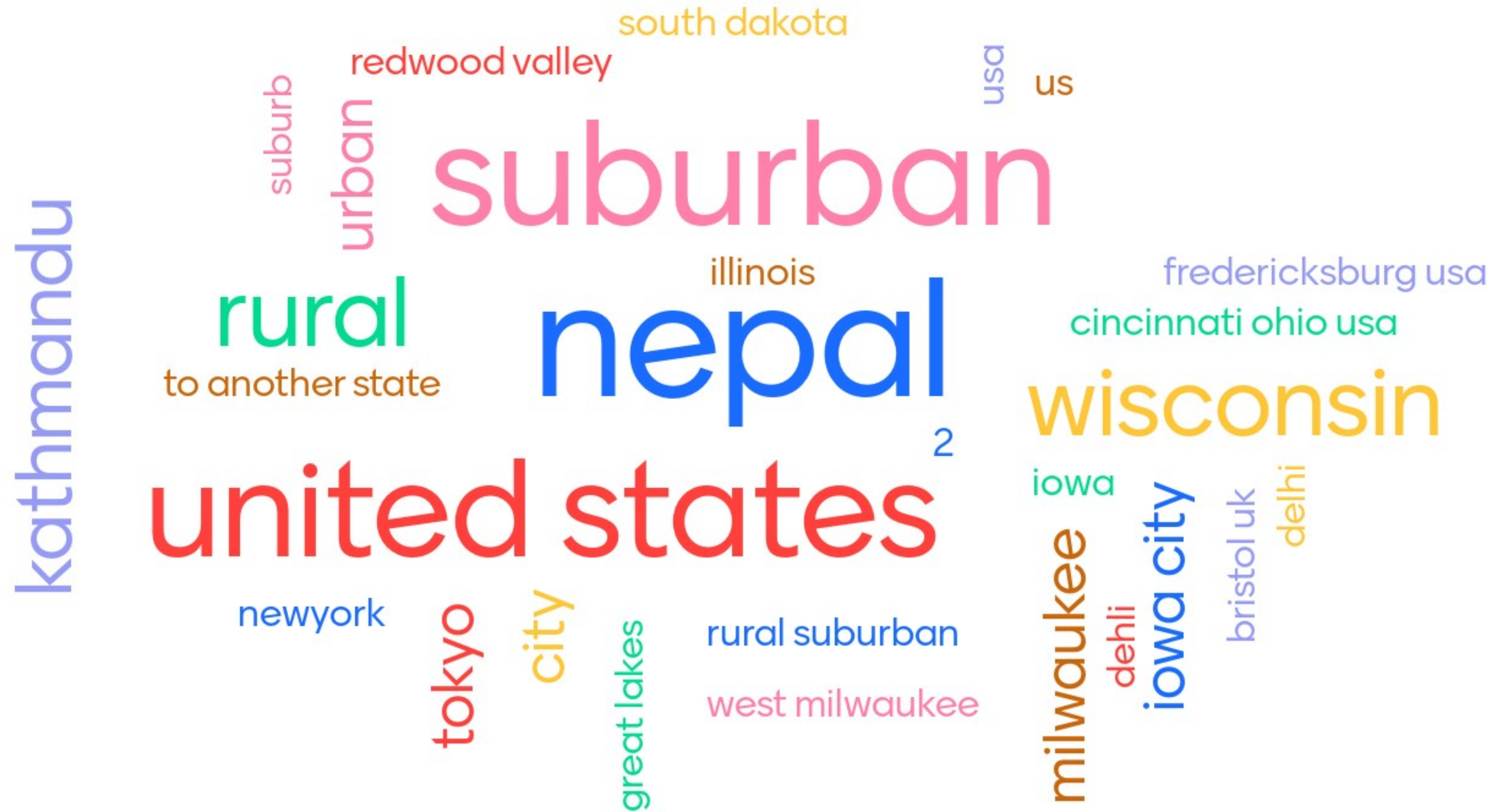

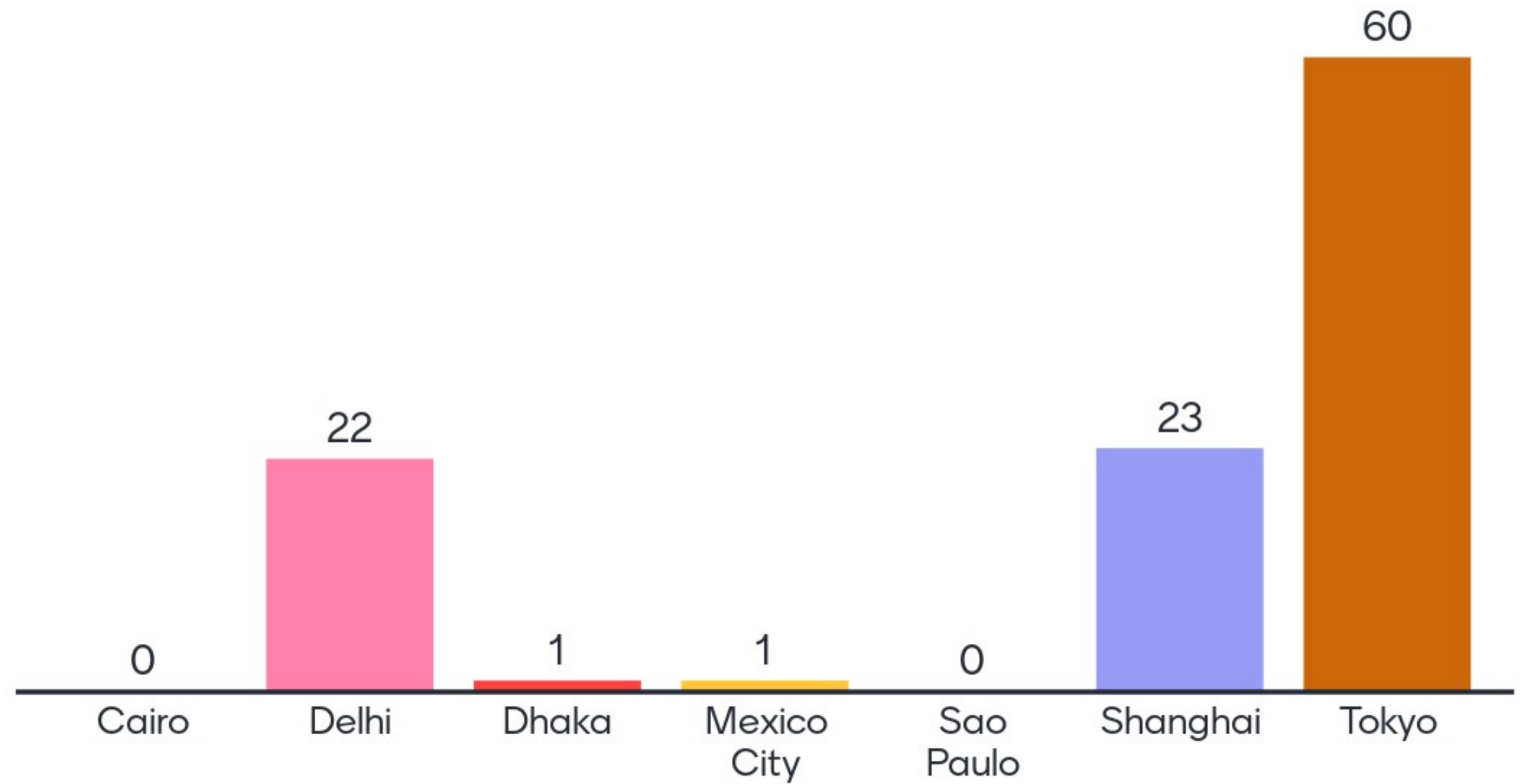

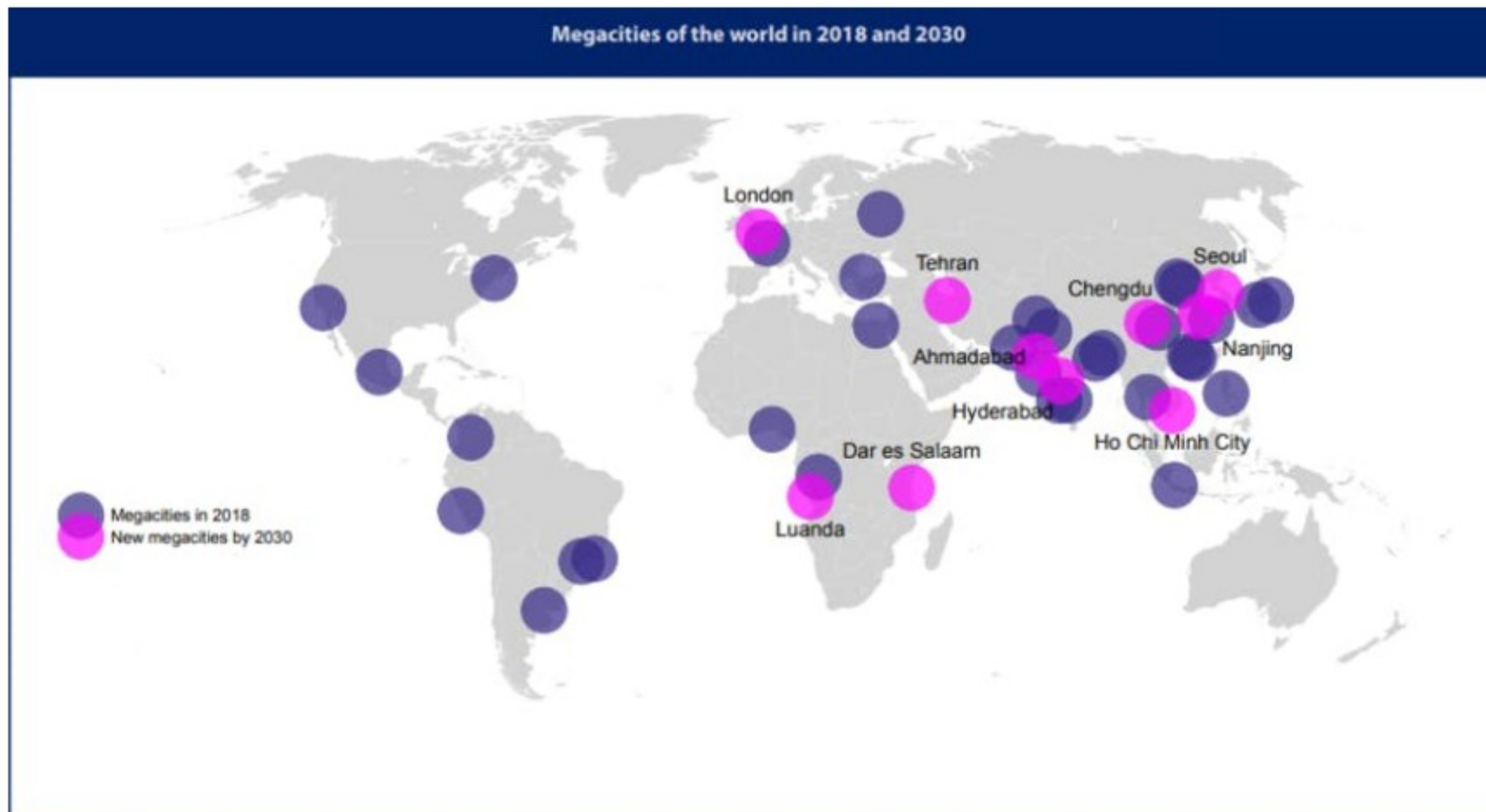

MEGA cities - What is the most populated city in the world

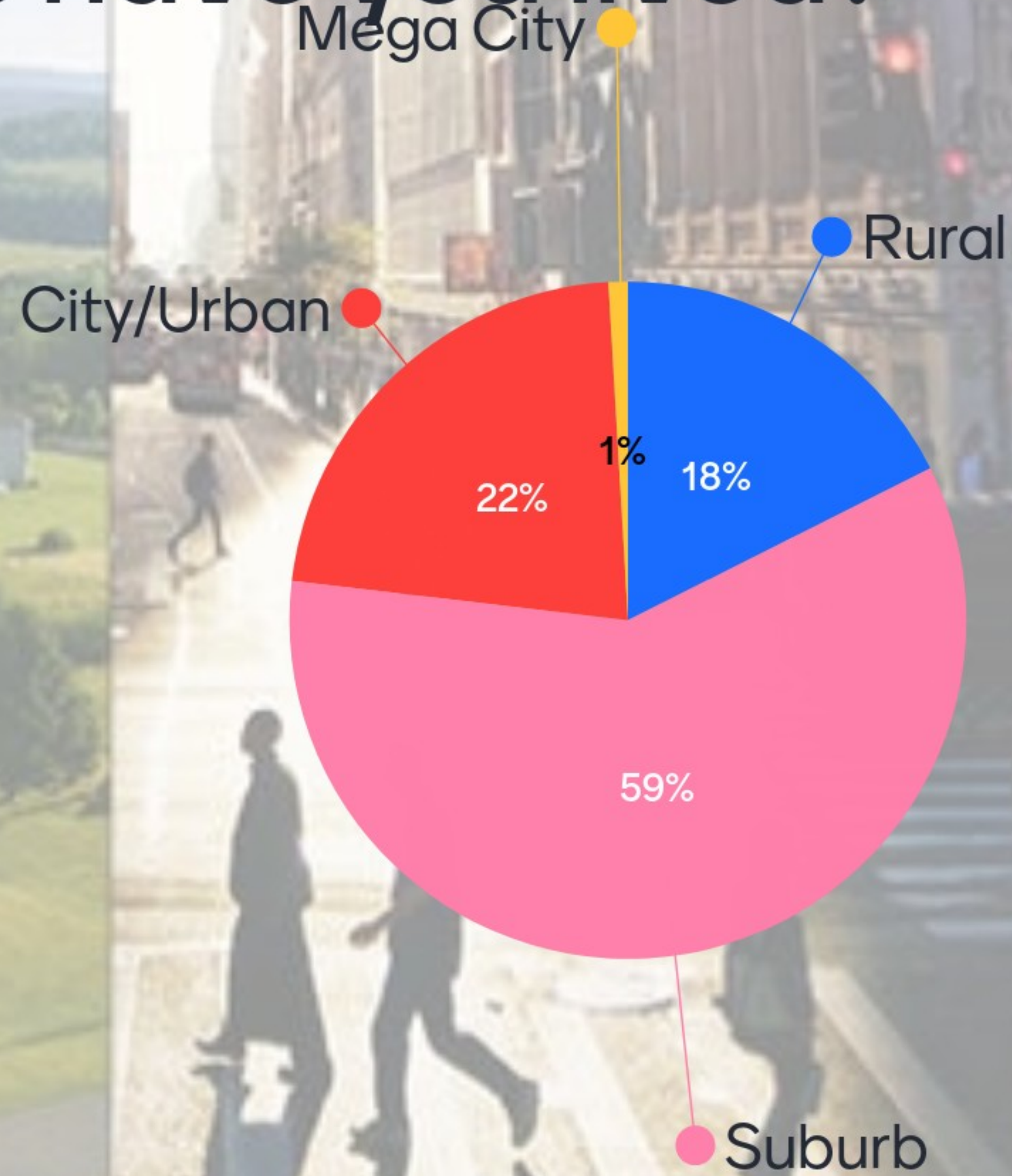




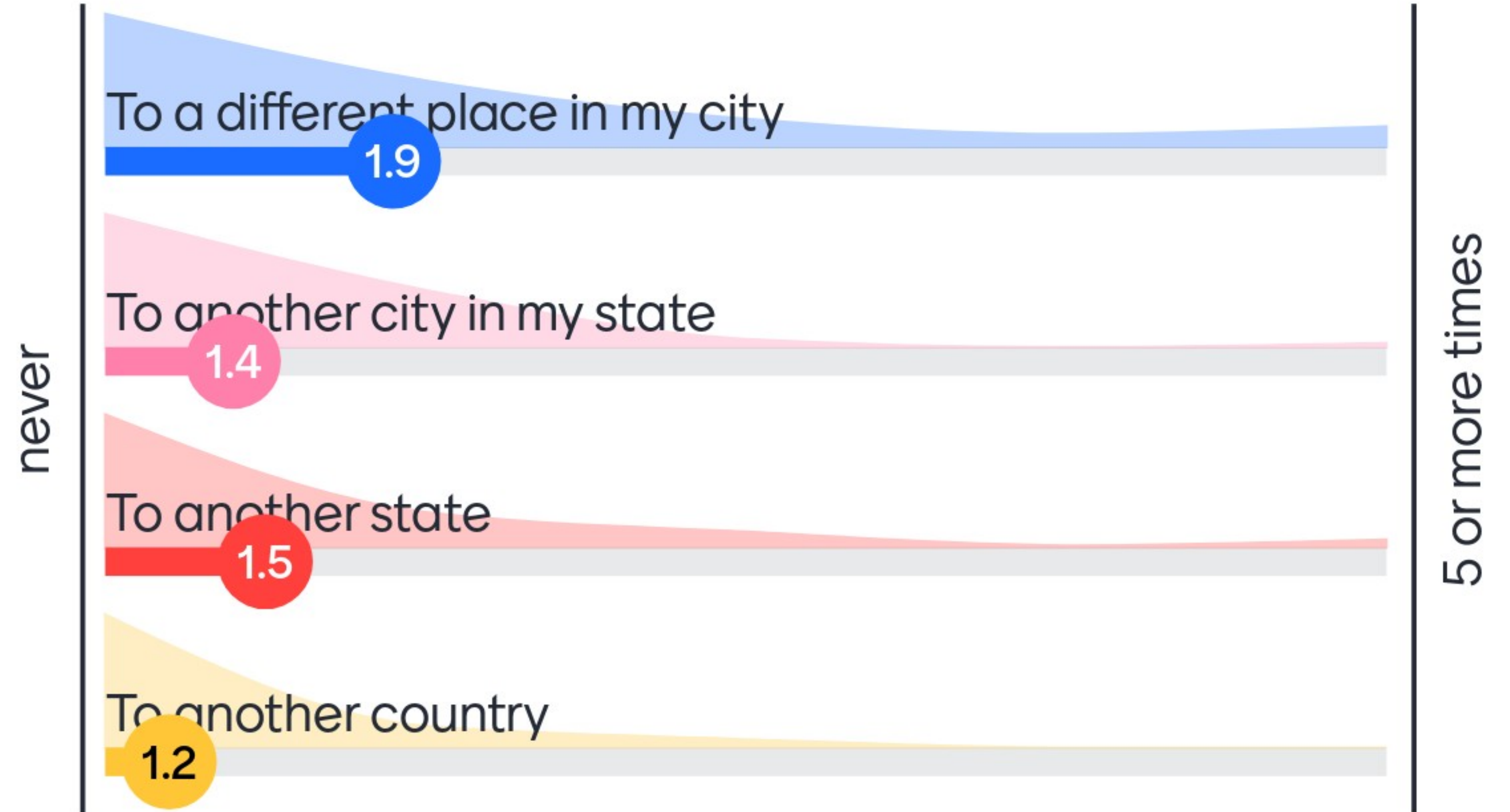
Most populated Cities in the World 2021

- Dhaka, Bangladesh - 20.2 million

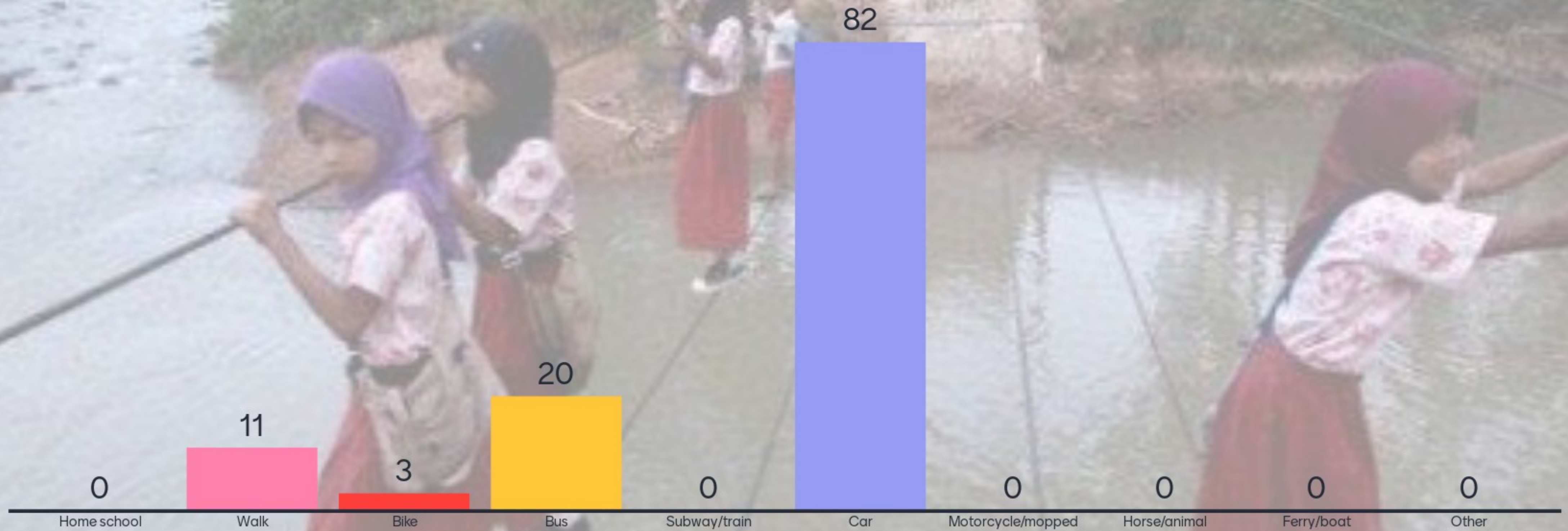

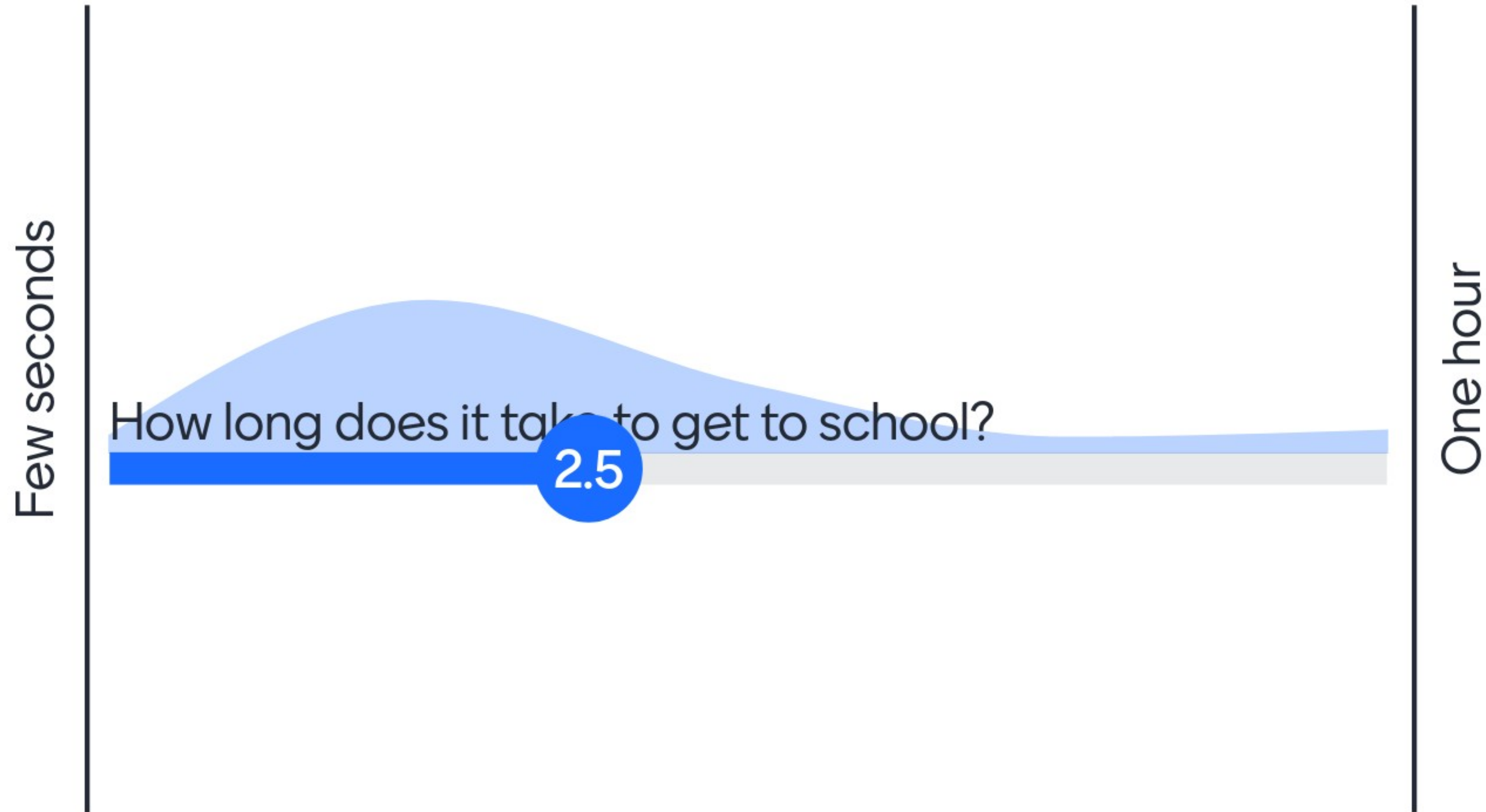

How do you get to school - pick all that apply

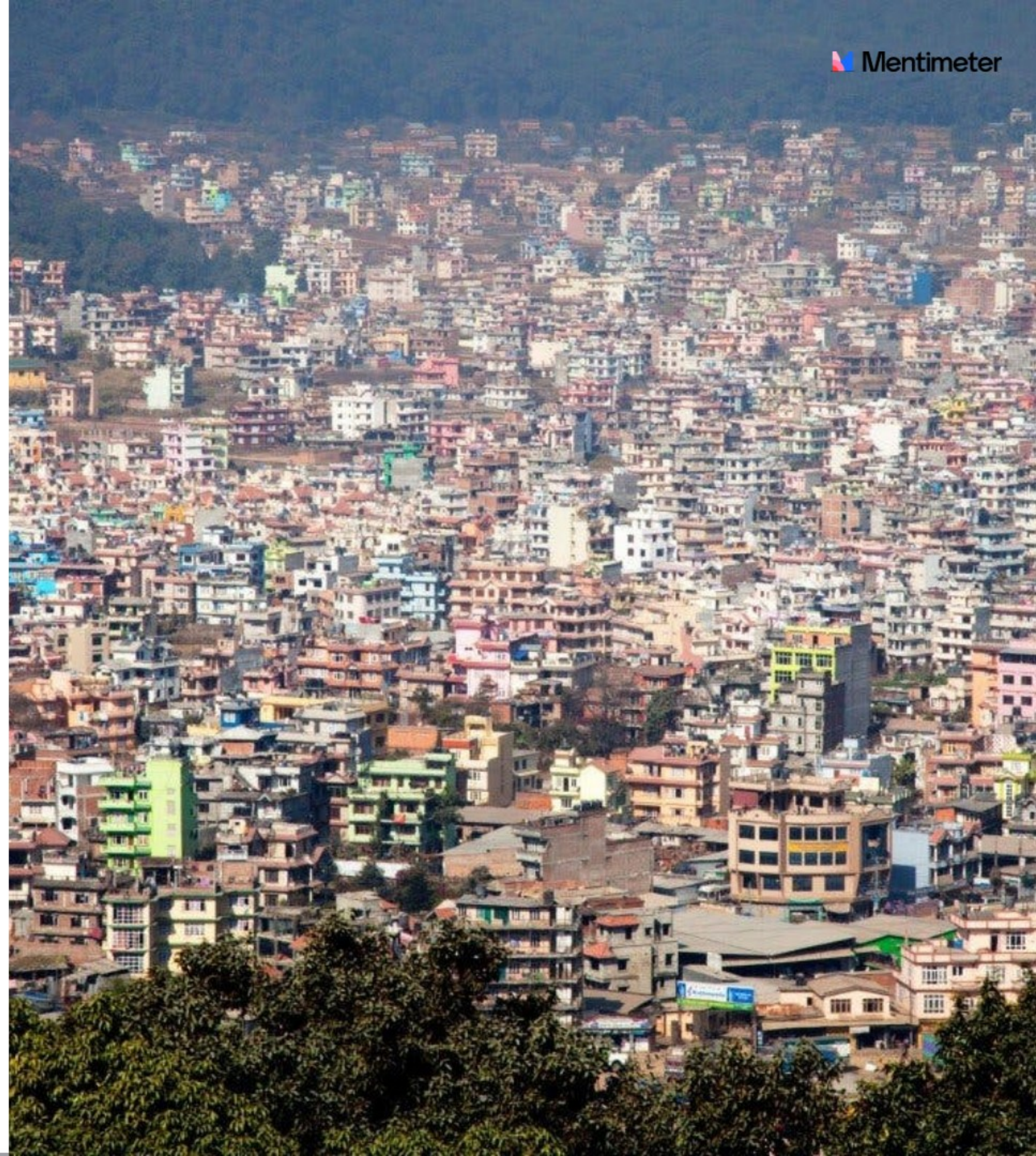


How long does it take to get to school?

% of registered voters who identify as ...

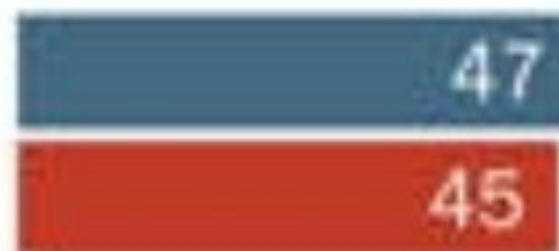
■ Democrat/Lean Democratic
■ Republican/Lean Republican



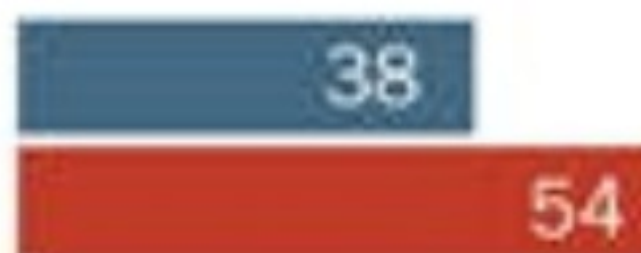

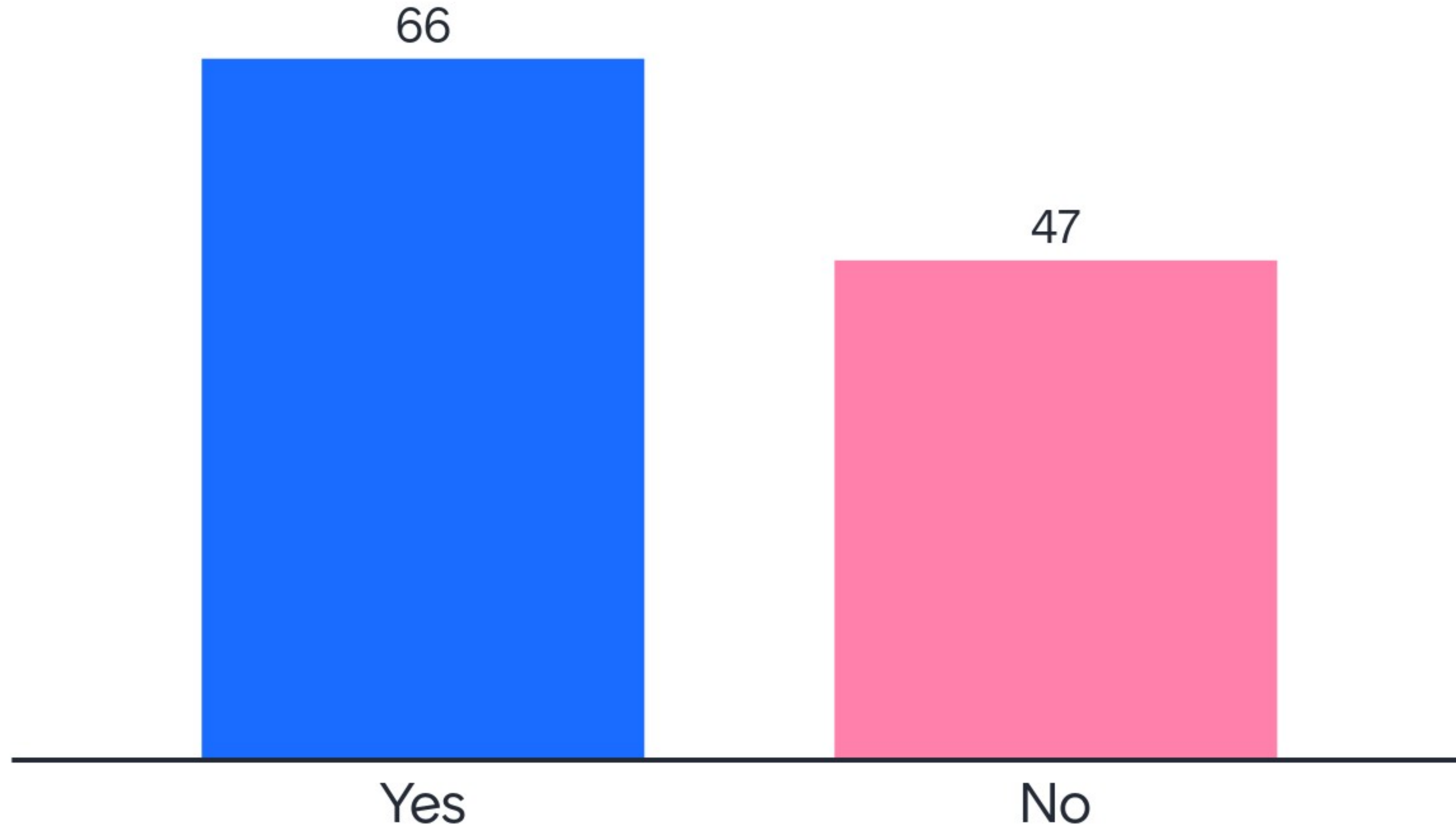

Do you know most of your neighbors?

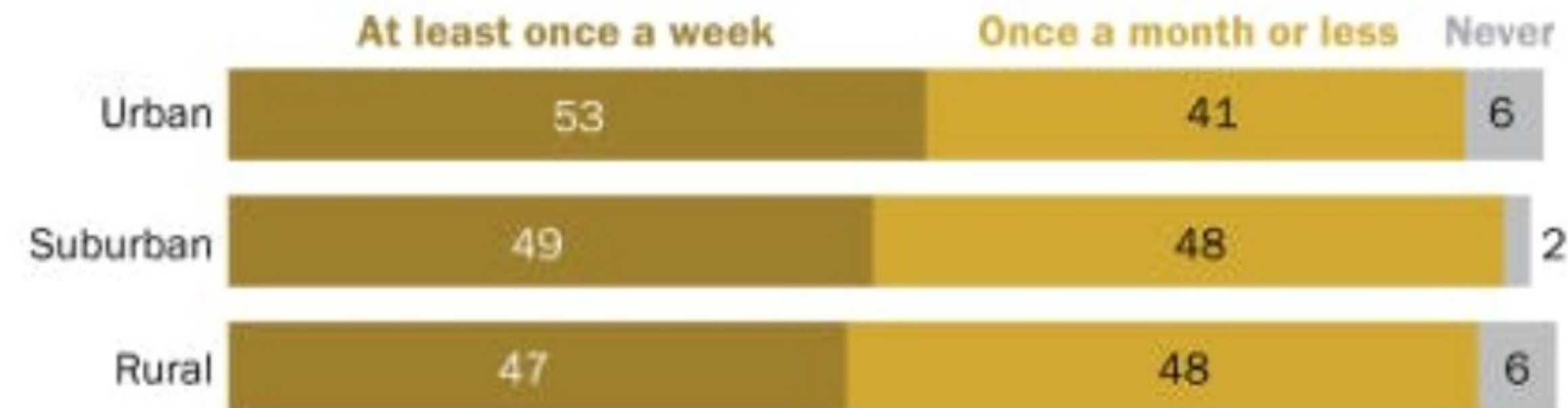


Rural residents are more likely to know most or all neighbors – but not to interact with them

% saying they have face-to-face conversations with any of their neighbors, among those who know at least some of their neighbors

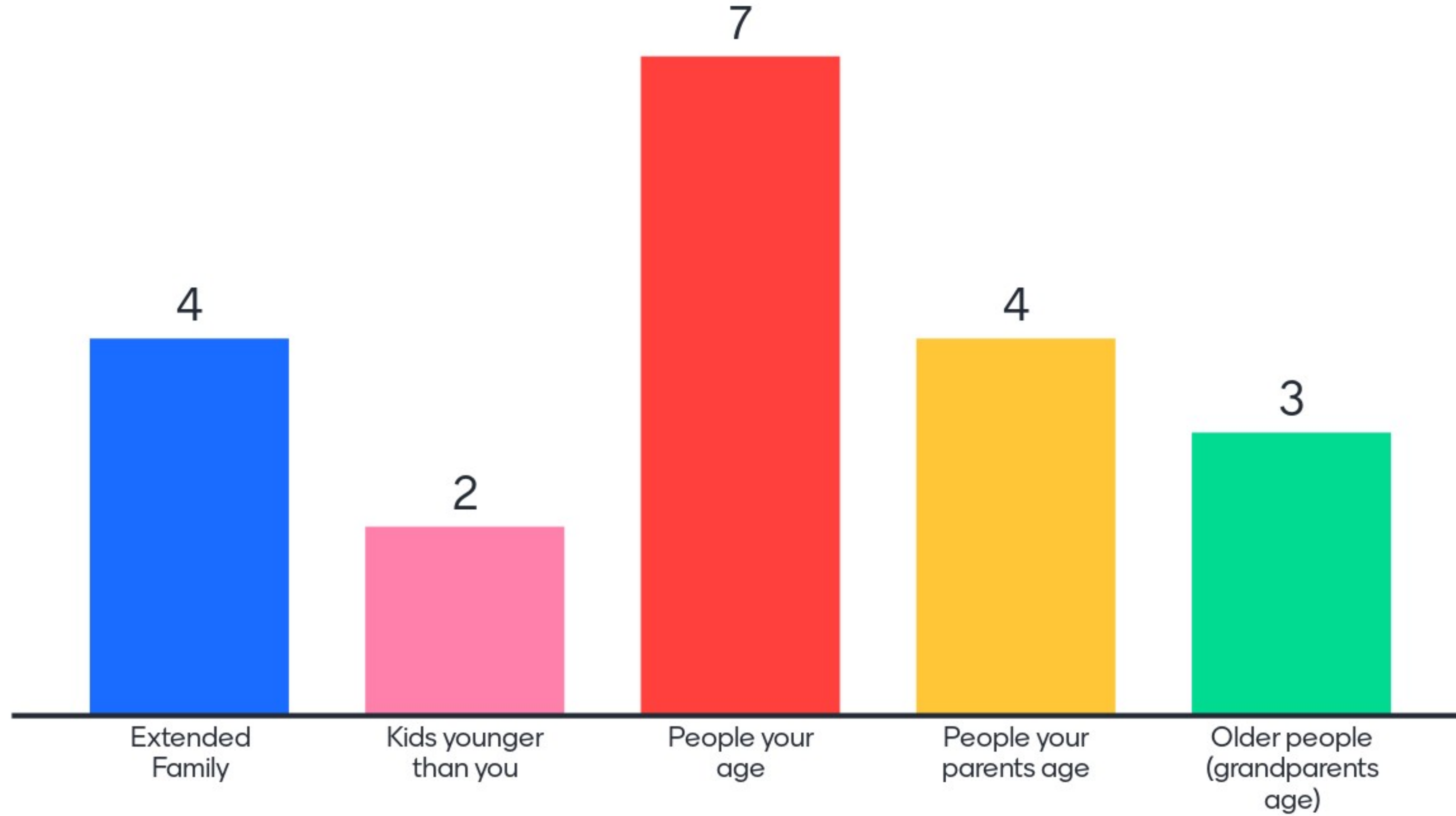
